Making its debut in Annapolis at the U.S. Sailboat Show is the redesigned inflatable Tiwal 3 folding sailboat. This compact sailboat makes a great sailing tender or is easily transported in the trunk of a car. Stored in its two bags, you can take the Tiwal 3 anywhere without a trailer. It is easily assembled in 20 minutes without special tools using clips and Velcro. The secret is the redesigned folding framework that allows the sailor to sit outboard for better control. The Tiwal 3 is available with either a 56- or a 75-square-foot single sail.

HALLBERG-RASSY

This brand-new Frers-designed Hallberg-Rassy packs a lot of cruising comfort in an offshore capable hull. Like its big sister HR44, the 340 has twin rudder blades for better control, especially in rough weather, and twin helms. The headsail furler is an Furlex TD mounted under the deck and all sail controls are led aft. Hallberg-Rassy offers a large folding transom for the first time in this size of boat. Down below, the galley is tucked to starboard beside the companionway, making it a great space to cook while in a seaway and creating more room in the light and airy saloon.
